A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Our faith is meant to be life giving. From the moment of creation when Genesis tells us that God “blew the breath of life” into the first man and woman, to Jesus declaring, “I am the bread of life”, our faith is about life, now and eternally.

The St. Paul VI evangelization team soon to be formed will be the Evangelization Animators. Animator Jennifer Yuh Nelson wrote, “A lot of time in animation is spent getting the story right—that’s something you can’t rush.” We have the most important story of all, the story of Jesus Christ to share. And each one of us is needed to bring that story to life in our own day and circumstances. Sometimes we need to be reminded of all the ways we can do that—through our prayer, our worship, our witness, our service to those in need. Our Evangelization Animators will help us to remember, to be aware, to share the life of faith.

Jesus said, “I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly.” Can we too be life-bringers through sharing our faith in the One who has brought us abundant life for eternity?
