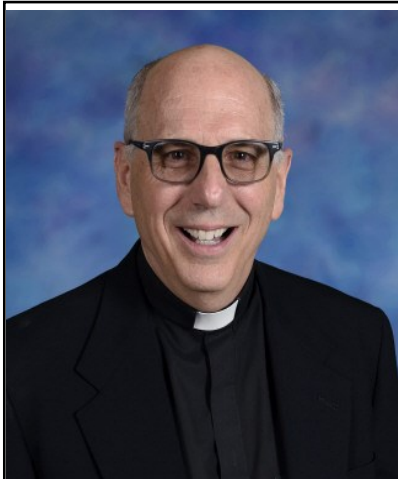

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Do you remember your parents asking you, “What did you learn today?” Maybe you have asked your own children the same question. Learning is important and lifelong! Michelangelo, when he was 87 years old said, “I am still learning.”

The learning that takes place in our Religious Education and SPRED sessions is critical for our young people’s growth in faith. Our Religious Education programs will begin on September 18th. We are blessed to have a special place for RE at the newly dedicated St. Hugh Faith Formation Center. We are blessed to have Ms. Elizabeth Kos as our Director of Youth Faith Formation and Ms. Julie Paitl as our Religious Education Program Coordinator. We are blessed with the people who have been called to be catechists and responded yes.

All these faith-filled people will build on the foundation that parents, the first catechists, have built. The role of parents, grandparents, and extended family is still key as young people deepen their understanding of the faith through their experiences of Sunday Mass, service to others, prayer, and community. These family experiences nourish and make faith real.

But RE and SPRED are more than knowledge and experiences, as important as those are to grow faith. RE and SPRED are first about each young person’s relationship with Jesus Christ and the community of faith.

Which brings us back to the question, “What did you learn today?” Did you get a new insight into Jesus and his words through Scripture? Did wisdom come through prayer or did you learn about being a disciple through the example of another person?

We want our children to learn all their academic subjects. Isn’t learning faith even more important? We would not send a child to second grade and then skip a few grades, hoping when we send the child back it will be okay. Likewise, I don’t think any of us would go to a doctor who hasn’t learned anything since graduating from medical school. What will you and I do, not only to be sure our children grow in faith but to grow ourselves in our knowledge and love of Jesus?

Alpha is one way for us to grow as adults. It begins at Mater Christ on September 23rd. See this week’s article for more information.

What if our children and grandchildren ask us, “What have you learned today?” It is part of our baptismal promises that we will share the Good News. We are all called to learn and to share what we know about Jesus and his great love for all of us. What better example can we give to our children than to continue our own faith learning!

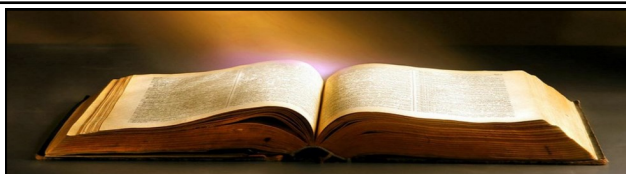

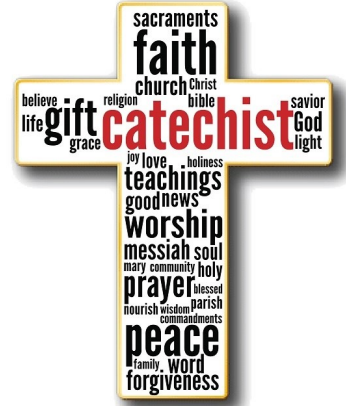

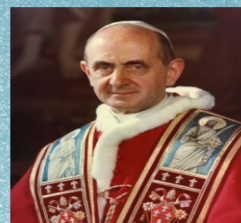

Please join us for a special Mass for the Feast of St. Paul VI. Our new vicariate shepherd, Bishop Kevin Birmingham, will install our Pastor, Father Tom May and present our Associate Pastor Father Matthew Nemchausky, our staff, Pastoral Council, and Finance Council. A Ministry Fair will be held in an effort to familiarize and have the opportunity to meet and greet with the many ministries and organizations.

What is Alpha?

We are about to embark on a parish journey to fan the flames of our faith and to invite others to experience our faith community. As a community with a rich history and a new identity, this is a perfect time to come together and learn about each other.

Alpha started in 1977 in England. People no longer assumed that God was true, or the Bible was trustworthy. People were asking what was real. The founding pastor, Nicky Gumbel, designed Alpha as a "place" of hospitality, and a safe environment for people to voice their questions and express their points of view whatever those might be.

Alpha has spread across the globe and over 30 million people have done Alpha. A few years ago, the Archdiocese of Chicago recommended Alpha to re-energize parishes and to exercise our mission to share the Good News of Jesus. The Alpha experience is simple: a small group of 8-10 people gather with a host and a helper, both of whom have been trained. Food is shared, followed by a video message. The host then leads the group in discussion. The meeting lasts about two hours.

Alpha has changed individuals and parishes across the world! **Alpha will start on Thursday, September 23rd.** Mater Christi will host the weekly event for the entire parish on Thursdays from 6:30-8:30 PM in the Marian Room of Mater Christi Church at 2401 S 10th Ave. North Riverside. Meet the Staff



My name is Jennifer Fangmann and I'm introducing myself as your interim Director of Operations and also announcing that this role will be ending for me soon. I have been a member of St Mary parish since moving to the area 25 years ago and have 4 daughters who are attending St Mary School and Trinity High School. Through the years I have been involved in many ministries in the church and school and have served in leadership positions in several. My faith is rooted deeply in a sense of place, expressed in both physical surroundings but also a sense of safety and peace in the relationships in the community. That's why I was honored when Father Tom offered me this new position in 2019 when Celina Zalas retired. Because of the generosity of contributors to the Building for the Future capital campaign, I was privileged to be able to tackle several projects to address deferred maintenance, such as masonry repairs (being done in several phases), repair of parking lots, and flooring and lighting upgrades in our oldest classrooms. But the biggest project of course was guiding the rebirth of PNC Bank in downtown Riverside to become the Bishop Lyne Pastoral Center. The new "center" of our parish life got a delayed start due to COVID sending everyone home shortly after the staff occupied the building, but there is new energy now that it has been properly dedicated to St Paul VI parish. As Father Tom and I learned more about the vision the Archdiocese has set out for the Director of Operations position, we found it also entails prayerful consideration of how to allocate all kinds of resources - financial, technological, and human resources in addition to facility space. I hope that my work in setting a firm foundation on how all of this can be done in support of the pastoral mission and ministries of the parish will become clear in the years to come. There is a talented and experienced staff in place for St Paul VI created from the original three communities, and we are working diligently to learn from each other. During the course of the transition this summer, I feel the Holy Spirit was at work in many ways, even in the circumstance of my being offered a job to return to my former employer. With the blessing of Father Tom, I will be stepping down from serving as Operations Director just before Labor Day. Jennifer Pondel has been named as my replacement, and with Jennifer and the rest of the Operations team, St Paul VI will continue to prosper and bring the good news to the western suburbs.
