Carol stepped in as president of the Guild in 2018. Since 2021, she has been a welcoming presence to the women of all three legacy parishes attending our St. Paul VI monthly gatherings at Mater Christi. Her vivacious personality and sense of humor are thoroughly engaging!

We also honored Gerry Dulik (Mater Christi) and Mary Ann Doornbos (St. Hugh) who were chosen to be women of the year in 2020, but weren't able to be honored at that time.

### Women's Society projects

**Feeding the Hungry:** Do you enjoy cooking? There is opportunity and need for volunteers to help feed the hungry at a homeless shelter located on Lake Street in Oak Park, through Housing Forward.

The first Friday of each month, generous cooks provide a total of 40 dinners. Each volunteer makes 5-10 dinners of a menu of their choosing comprising an entree, a vegetable, and a dessert.

Containers are supplied (we'll have a donation jar to help pay for the containers). Meals are dropped off at Kathy Burns' home in North Riverside, and she delivers them to the shelter. If you are interested in this worthy deed, please contact her at burns.kathleen@comcast.net.

Burying Veterans: The Women's Society's Respect Life Committee had a special parish collection in May to celebrate our veterans. The former Mater Christi Women's Guild had worked with Hines VA and a low-cost cremation service to cremate four deceased veterans whose families were in dire need of assistance. Veterans receive free interment at any national cemetery, but embalming or cremation services are not included. Many of our veterans are forgotten, homeless, or suffer from illness. As of August 18 we had collected \$2,758. We will keep the parish posted on our progress as we identify veterans who need our help. Thank you for your generosity!
