Dear Friends,

St. Paul VI parish community has many reasons to celebrate this past year. Eighty-five children received the sacrament of First Communion, and eighty-four young adults received the sacrament of Confirmation through the combined efforts of parents, catechists, Religious Education, and St. Mary School. We have also joyfully welcomed over seventy children into the faith through the sacrament of Baptism. We have had the pleasure of celebrating ten weddings and accompanying over seventy families as they laid their loved ones to rest. We continue to provide food to the hungry, assistance to the poor, and comfort to those who are in need through our many organizations and groups. All this good work is possible because of the generous hearts and willing hands of the people of St. Paul VI.

As we approach the end of our fiscal year, we are forecasting a year-end deficit of approximately \$142,000. 61% of that number is due to a shortfall in our Sunday collections, which are the primary revenue source upon which the budget is based. There were unexpected projects that needed immediate action this fiscal year and added to the current year's shortfall. Those projects included repairing the water main break at St. Mary Church in July, the roof replacement on the parish office building, and the replacement of an air handler at the Parish Center. Due to your generosity, both our Christmas and Easter collections surpassed their respective budgeted goals - which did help our bottom line. There is a seasonal pattern to Sunday giving; collections significantly dip during June, July, and August. As we approach these months, please keep your giving consistent. Setting up a schedule for online giving truly helps the parish year-round.

We need your help and ask if you would prayerfully deliberate taking the following actions:

• First, please consider making a year-end gift to the parish. Every dollar received will go toward our budget shortfall. You can donate by scanning the QR code on this letter, visiting our website, and clicking the Year End Gift icon, or dropping a check in the collection baskets at either worship site or at the parish office located at 40 E. Burlington in Riverside.
