



## A message from our Associate Pastor

Well Hello There!

Hello St. Paul VI community, it's my pleasure to write to you this first bulletin article! You've all heard by now that a new priest has been assigned to St. Paul VI. I thought I'd take this opportunity to tell you a little bit about myself. I grew up in Houston, TX but came to Chicago to attend Loyola University Chicago. I was commissioned as an officer in the Illinois Army National Guard and became a MEDEVAC helicopter pilot, flying out of Midway Airport and served

for 8 ½ years. It was also in Chicago that I decided to become Catholic and was received into the Church on Easter Vigil 2014 at St. George Catholic Church in Tinley Park.

My faith journey is a bit of an odd story. My brother, my three sisters, and I decided to start going to church on our own as adolescents. We joined a Christian Reformed church and I was baptized as a sophomore in high school. In college I fell away from the faith but after a skydiving mishap while I was in Flight School I decided to start seeking God again. Through the help of a friend I was introduced to Bishop Baron's Catholicism series, the Catechism of the Catholic Church, and a variety of talks given by great Catholic speakers through Lighthouse Catholic Media. Through a period of learning about the Church I realized that I had found what I had been looking for all along and became convicted of the truth of the Catholic faith. I then made the decision to join RCIA and become Catholic.

After two years in the house of discernment for Chicago, and six years at Mundelein Seminary I was ordained to the priesthood on May 18th. I've only been a priest for about a month and a half now but what I have experienced in priestly ministry so far has been a further confirmation that I am where the Lord wants me to be. It's been a pleasure to get to know some of you already and to take part in various parish events.

I golf, but not well. I make rosaries and frankincense scented candles. I recently discovered that I like escape rooms. I never did get that skydiving license, but I am a PADI certified scuba diver and I still have my pilot's license. My confirmation Saint is St. Augustine, but I also claim St. Joseph of Cupertino (The patron saint of pilots) and St. Maximilian Kolbe as patron saints as well. I also love to cook, my favorite dish to make is octopus!

I look forward to meeting and spending time with each of you. I would love to come over for dinner or to give a house blessing.

#### **GOSPEL MEDITATION**

## ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE By Father John Muir

14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Recently I watched a bunch of YouTube videos on how to optimize willpower in the face of weakness. The message was: do not accept your weakness. Crush it. Dominate it. In one video, however, at the end of a rant by a willpower coach, the muscular stoic admitted, "You'll never actually get what you want, no matter how hard you try." Amazingly, he admitted that willpower alone is not sufficient for us weak-willed humans.

What does God want us to do with our weaknesses, if crushing them with willpower won't work? For example, what should I do with my tendency to arrogance and self-isolation? Or my procrastination? Or my intellectual and physical limitations? Or my selfishness?

The counter-intuitive answer is clear in this week's words from St Paul, "I will rather boast most gladly of my weaknesses in order that the power of Christ may dwell in me (2 Cor. 12:9)." Boast of our weaknesses? Paul isn't promoting weak-mindedness or laziness. Rather, he perceives that Jesus loves us not despite our weaknesses but because of them. Boasting of our weakness means claiming human will is not all we have. It means turning to God whenever we feel weak, which-let's face it—is almost all the time. When we do, we learn to love our weaknesses, because it's there that we meet the strength of Christ. This week, I challenge us to find ways to boast not in willpower but in weakness. ©LPi

#### Bryant's Building Blog

Happy Summer! We are excited to announce we had the roof around the Mater Christi Steeple repaired! There was a small leak to repair and thankfully we found it before it turned into a bigger problem. The cost was \$5000 which also included reattaching the corner ornament that fell off the steeple back in 2015. The ornament should be going back up any day now! We are just waiting for them to reweld the stainless steel to the base as the original hold method has failed.

On another note, we had to replace the fire alarm panel at Mater Christi. The sump pump in the elevator pit failed and we found 3ft of water in the pit. The water shorted out the fire alarm panel as some of the electric components for the panel are in the pit. The cost of the fire panel replacement and upgrade to the annunciator panel was \$2500. I was able to replace the pump. Your continued generosity enables us to take care of these and many other campus needs.

We are looking to re-start up the Building and Grounds advisory committee. If you are interested in being part of this committee, feel free to email me at brouleau@stpaulviparish.org or call the parish office at 708-447-1020 and ask for me. We will meet quarterly to discuss what is going on around the parish campuses.

The parish has started a Creation Cares Committee. This committee is to help inform the parish on how to be green while also looking into how the campuses can steward our resources in alignment with Pope Francis' call to care for the earth.
