The tradition of Las Posadas (the inns) was brought to Mexico from Spain by Catholic Missionaries in 1586. It commemorates the journey Mary and Joseph made while searching for shelter in Bethlehem before baby Jesus' birth. At St. Paul VI, children dressed as Mary, Joseph, and the angel will lead us from door to door searching for a place to stay. At each stop, we will sing songs and say prayers. Everyone will be given a guide that will have all the lyrics and prayers. First-time participants are welcome! Once Mary and Joseph find a place to stay, we will all join together in a celebration with traditional foods and drinks. One of the most exciting elements of our celebration is the starshaped piñatas filled with candy and toys. The piñatas are in the shape of colorful seven-pointed stars, which are said to have guided the Three Wise Men to the newborn Jesus. All kids will receive a bolo (or little bag) or candy before they leave!
