# Support for Misericordia

At our Nov. 7 meeting, our members approved a \$100 donation for Misericordia. This nonprofit offers a continuum of care for developmentally disabled persons. Currently it serves 600 children and adults in residence. Misericordia is a charity of the Archdiocese of Chicago operated by the Sisters of Mercy. The gap between state funding and program expenses is nearly \$20 million, so Misericordia relies heavily on private funds as well.

This fall, our Society purchased 500 microwaveable containers for dinners our volunteers make for the homeless in the Housing Forward shelter in Oak Park, Members



generously donated \$147, and the society paid the \$191 balance.

The first Friday of each month, generous cooks provide a total of 40 dinners. Each volunteer makes 5-10 dinners of a menu of their choosing comprising an entree, a vegetable, and a dessert.
